SENATE BILL NO. 1133

BY JUDICIARY AND RULES COMMITTEE

2 RELATING TO THE SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON CRIMINAL JUSTICE REINVESTMENT OVER-
3 SIGHT; AMENDING SECTION 67-456, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE THE DATE WHEN THE
4 COMMITTEE SHALL CEASE TO EXIST.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 67-456, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
7 amended to read as follows:

8 67-456. SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON CRIMINAL JUSTICE REINVESTMENT OVER-
9 SIGHT. (1) In order to maintain continuous oversight of the Idaho criminal
10 justice reinvestment initiative and related issues, there is hereby estab-
11 lished a special legislative committee on justice reinvestment oversight.

12 (2) The committee shall consist of five (5) members of the senate, one
13 (1) of whom shall be the chairperson of the senate judiciary and rules com-
14 mittee, two (2) from the majority party appointed by the president pro tem-
15 pore of the senate and two (2) from the minority party appointed by the mi-
16 nority leader, and five (5) members of the house of representatives, one (1)
17 of whom shall be the chairperson of the house judiciary, rules and adminis-
18 tration committee, two (2) from the majority party appointed by the speaker
19 of the house and two (2) from the minority party appointed by the minority
20 leader. The cochairs of the special committee shall be the chairperson of
21 the senate judiciary and rules committee and the chairperson of the house ju-
22 diciary, rules and administration committee. Appointments to the committee
23 shall be for the term of office of the member appointed. Any vacancy shall
24 be filled in a manner consistent with the appointment procedure set forth in
25 this subsection, except the appointment shall be for the remainder of the un-
26 expired term. A committee member may be reappointed to the committee.

27 (3) The cochairs may appoint advisors with expertise in Idaho's crim-
28 inal justice system and are expected to receive input and technical assis-
29 tance from the council of state governments justice center. Any advisors to
30 the committee who are not legislative members shall not be reimbursed from
31 legislative funds for per diem, mileage or other expenses and shall not have
32 voting privileges.

33 (4) The committee shall have as a primary duty and responsibility the
34 task of monitoring, studying and guiding analysis and policy development in
35 all aspects of the criminal justice system in Idaho including, but not lim-
36 ited to, monitoring performance and outcome measures as set forth in the jus-
37 tice reinvestment act and studying the data-driven justice reinvestment and
38 resource allocation approach and policies to improve public safety, reduce
39 recidivism and reduce spending on corrections in Idaho.

40 (5) By no later than February 1 of each year, the committee shall report
41 to the legislature on its activities and findings and may report and make

1 recommendations on any aspect of the Idaho criminal justice system in this
2 state at any time.

3 (6) Members of the committee shall be compensated from the legislative
4 account on order of the president pro tempore of the senate or the speaker of
5 the house of representatives at the rates applicable for committee members
6 of the legislative council.

7 (7) The special committee shall cease to exist following its report to
8 the first regular session of the sixty-~~five~~seventh Idaho legislature in
9 201923.
