

## STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

### RS27075

This legislation assists school boards to complete their required annual evaluation for superintendents. It provides sample evaluation criteria, which is approved by the State Board of Education, or allows them to create their own customized superintendent evaluation based on core elements from the State Board of Education. The intent is to clarify the process and allow school boards to bring focus to a minimal number of key performance indicators associated with student achievement. Additionally, this will utilize existing reporting and bring uniformity to the process of accountability concerning senior level leadership in our Local Education Agencies (LEA).

### FISCAL NOTE

There is no fiscal impact to either the state or the local education agencies. This process should be currently occurring on an annual basis. Reporting requirements can be incorporated into current state reporting mechanisms.
