AN ACT

1 RELATING TO PARDON, COMMUTATION, OR REMISSION OF FINES AND FORFEITURES;
2 AMENDING CHAPTER 2, TITLE 20, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SEC-
3 TION 20-240B, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL
4 HAVE CERTAIN DUTIES REGARDING A PARDON, COMMUTATION, OR REMISSION OF
5 FINES AND FORFEITURES; AND REPEALING SECTION 20-232, IDAHO CODE, RELAT-
6 ING TO REMISSION OF A FINE OR PENALTY.
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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. That Chapter 2, Title 20, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
10 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and des-
11 ignated as Section 20-240B, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

12 20-240B. NOTICE OF PARDON, COMMUTATION, OR REMISSION OF FINES AND FOR-
13 FEITURES. When, by action of the commission or the governor, a pardon, commu-
14 tation, or remission of fines and forfeitures is granted as provided by law,
15 the executive director shall:

16 (1) Retain an original pardon, commutation, or remission of fines and
17 forfeitures document at the commission;

18 (2) File a copy of the original pardon, commutation, or remission of
19 fines and forfeitures document in the office of the secretary of state;

20 (3) Provide an original pardon, commutation, or remission of fines and
21 forfeitures document to the individual petitioner;

22 (4) File notice with the state courts, in a manner approved by the
23 supreme court, that a pardon, commutation, or remission of fines and forfei-
24 tures has been granted in the case; and

25 (5) Provide such additional notice that a pardon, commutation, or re-
26 mission of fines and forfeitures has been granted as the commission may adopt
27 by rule.

28 SECTION 2. That Section 20-232, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
29 repealed.
