4	SUMER PROTECTION ACT, TO PROVIDE A SHORT TITLE, TO DEFINE TERMS, TO PRO-
5	VIDE FOR KRATOM PRODUCT LIMITATIONS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR VIOLATIONS.

- 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
- 7 SECTION 1. That Title 22, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended 8 by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW CHAPTER</u>, to be known and designated as Chap-9 ter 55, Title 22, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

10 CHAPTER 55 11 IDAHO KRATOM CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT

22-5501. SHORT TITLE. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Idaho Kratom Consumer Protection Act."

22-5502. DEFINITIONS. As used in this act:

- (1) "Food" means a food, food product, food ingredient, dietary ingredient, dietary supplement, or beverage for human consumption.
- (2) "Kratom product" means a food that contains any part of the leaf of the plant Mitragyna speciosa or an extract of it with a level of 7-hydrox-ymitragynine in the alkaloid fraction that is less than two percent (2%) of the overall alkaloid composition of the product and is manufactured as a powder, capsule, pill, beverage, or other edible form. All kratom products are foods.
- (3) "Processor" means a person who sells, prepares, manufactures, distributes, or maintains kratom products or advertises, represents, or holds himself out as selling, preparing, or maintaining kratom products.
- (4) "Retailer" means any person who sells, distributes, advertises, represents, or holds himself out as selling or maintaining kratom products.
- 22-5503. KRATOM PRODUCT LIMITATIONS. A processor shall not prepare, distribute, sell, or expose for sale a kratom product that:
- (1) Is adulterated or contaminated with a prohibited nonkratom substance if the kratom product is mixed with or contains a prohibited substance listed in section 37-2732, Idaho Code; or
- (2) Artificially synthesizes or enhances the 7-hydroxymitragynine alkaloid composition of the product greater than the limits set forth in section 22-5502(3), Idaho Code.
- 22-5504. VIOLATIONS. (1) A processor or retailer that violates section 22-5503, Idaho Code, is subject to an administrative fine of not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for each offense.

(2) A retailer does not violate section 22-5503, Idaho Code, if it is shown by a preponderance of the evidence that the retailer relied in good faith on the representations of a manufacturer, processor, packer, or distributor of food represented to be a kratom product.
