RELATING TO EDUCATION; AMENDING CHAPTER 61, TITLE 33, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 33-6106, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FLEXIBLE SCHOOL SCHEDULES FOR CERTAIN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STUDENTS; AMENDING CHAPTER 61, TITLE 33, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 33-6107, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FLEXIBLE SCHEDULE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR KINDER-GARTEN THROUGH GRADE 3 STUDENTS; AMENDING CHAPTER 61, TITLE 33, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 33-6108, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FLEXIBLE SCHEDULE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR GRADE 4 THROUGH 6 STUDENTS; AMENDING CHAPTER 61, TITLE 33, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 33-6109, IDAHO CODE, TO ESTABLISH MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS REGARDING FLEXIBLE SCHOOL SCHEDULES FOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STUDENTS; AND AMENDING THE HEADING FOR CHAPTER 61, TITLE 33, IDAHO CODE.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 61, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 33-6106, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

- 33-6106. FLEXIBLE SCHEDULES FOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STUDENTS. (1) The legislature finds that elementary school students who are academically advanced and meet certain requirements set forth in this section and in section 33-6107 or 33-6108, Idaho Code, have earned the right to have a flexible school schedule.
- (2) A flexible schedule permits a student to have partial-day or full-day absences for the purpose of family activities, enrichment opportunities, and home-based educational activities.
- (3) A flexible schedule must be agreed upon by the student's parents or guardians, teacher, and principal. A written agreement that details the responsibilities of parents or guardians, the student, and the school, such as expectations, attendance requirements, student performance, and testing, is encouraged.
- (4) A student with a flexible schedule can be claimed by only one (1) school district as a home school district. For purposes of this chapter, a "home school district" means the school district in which a student attends more instructional hours than any other school district. The state department of education must fund the home school district as if the student were in attendance at the same average attendance rate as the other students in the school district, but not less than a rate of ninety-five percent (95%).
- (5) A student who is no longer advanced based on the criteria provided in section 33-6107 or 33-6108, Idaho Code, will no longer qualify for a flexible schedule and will be counted for funding based on regular attendance rules and policies.

SECTION 2. That Chapter 61, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a $\underline{\text{NEW SECTION}}$, to be known and designated as Section 33-6107, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

- 33-6107. FLEXIBLE SCHEDULE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA -- KINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE 3. (1) A student in kindergarten through grade 3 must be advanced in reading, writing, and mathematics in order to qualify for a flexible schedule.
- (2) To qualify as advanced in reading and writing, the student must test as proficient on the most recent Idaho reading indicator test, Idaho standards achievement test, or locally administered reading tool that tests proficiency for that student's grade level. The student must be rated as advanced by the student's teacher and must demonstrate writing competency based on the Idaho content standards for the grade level of the student. For reading and writing, the student must master the previous year's standards and show progress toward mastering the current year's reading and writing standards.
- (3) To qualify as advanced in mathematics, the student must, in the determination of the student's teacher, make significant progress toward mastering the skills in the Idaho content standards for mathematics for the student's grade level. The student must also make progress in math facts 0+0=0 through $12 \times 12 = 144$ and the corresponding subtraction and division math facts to the extent that by the end of grade 3 fluency will be achieved.
- (4) It is recommended that the school district provide to parents or guardians of elementary students with flexible schedules an electronic copy of the "core knowledge sequence," a publication issued by the core knowledge foundation, for guidance in mathematics and provide any other information on mathematical concepts that would be beneficial for students to learn in kindergarten through grade 3.
- SECTION 3. That Chapter 61, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 33-6108, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
- 33-6108. FLEXIBLE SCHEDULE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA -- GRADES 4 THROUGH 6. In order to qualify for a flexible schedule, a student in grades 4 through 6 must:
 - (1) Be rated as advanced by the student's teacher;
- (2) Satisfy mathematics requirements for earlier grades as provided in section 33-6107, Idaho Code; and
- (3) Be proficient in all subjects as determined by the most recent Idaho standards achievement test, district equivalent test, end-of-course assignment, or criteria set by the state board of education.
- SECTION 4. That Chapter 61, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 33-6109, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
- 33-6109. FLEXIBLE SCHEDULES FOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STUDENTS -- MIS-CELLANEOUS PROVISIONS. (1) A school district or public charter school may

use mastery-based criteria that show advancement to qualify kindergarten through grade 6 students for a flexible schedule.

- (2) School districts and public charter schools may but are not required to offer flexible schedules to their students. If flexible schedules are offered, the school district's or public charter school's policy on such schedules must comply with the provisions of this section and sections 33-6106 through 33-6108, Idaho Code.
- (3) The state department of education may review implementation of flexible schedules for elementary school students by school districts and public charter schools and make recommendations to the legislature regarding compliance.
- SECTION 5. That the Heading for Chapter 61, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:
