SENATE PROCLAMATION NO. 103

A PROCLAMATION

COMMENDING THE ADA COUNTY HIGHWAY DISTRICT ON ITS 50TH ANNIVERSARY.

We, the members of the Senate of the State of Idaho assembled in the First Regular Session of the Sixty-sixth Idaho Legislature, proclaim as follows:

WHEREAS, on May 25, 1971, Ada County voters created the Ada County Highway District (ACHD), the only single countywide highway district established under Idaho law; and

WHEREAS, since commencing work in 1972, ACHD and its elected commission have maintained almost all of the roads in Ada County, with the exception of roads that fall under private ownership or within the jurisdiction of the Idaho Transportation Department; and

WHEREAS, despite the enormous growth of Ada County and its transportation system, ACHD has accomplished the goals for which it was established, including countywide quality standards and the efficient allocation of resources; and

WHEREAS, ACHD has retained its commitment to its constituency, including a policy of filling reported potholes within 24 hours; and

WHEREAS, ACHD has continued to adapt to the changing demands of Ada County's citizens, as demonstrated by its adoption of a Complete Streets Policy to provide safe and comfortable travel for vehicles, bicycles, pedestrians, people with disabilities, and mass transit users; and

WHEREAS, ACHD is an Idaho leader in technology, design, and innovation and shares its expertise with other highway authorities in Idaho; and

WHEREAS, ACHD, its staff, and its commissioners have provided valuable service to the citizens of ${\tt Ada}$ County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED by the members of the Senate assembled in the First Regular Session of the Sixty-sixth Idaho Legislature that we congratulate ACHD for its success in addressing the unique transportation needs of Ada County for 50 years.
