HOUSE BILL NO. 449

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE
2 GENERAL FUND TO THE PEST CONTROL DEFICIENCY WARRANT FUND; APPROPRI-
3 ATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE HAZARDOUS
4 SUBSTANCE EMERGENCY RESPONSE FUND; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MON-
5 EYS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE WASTE TIRE DISPOSAL DEFICIENCY WARRANT
6 FUND; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated and the Office of the State Con-
10 troller shall transfer \$368,400 from the General Fund to the Pest Control
11 Deficiency Warrant Fund as soon as practicable for the period July 1, 2021,
12 through June 30, 2022. Such moneys shall be used to reimburse costs incurred
13 by the Plant Industries Program in the Department of Agriculture pursuant to
14 Section 22-2019, Idaho Code.

15 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated and the Office of the State Con-
16 troller shall transfer \$12,000 from the General Fund to the Hazardous Sub-
17 stance Emergency Response Fund as soon as practicable for the period July 1,
18 2021, through June 30, 2022. Such moneys shall be used to reimburse costs
19 incurred by the Office of Emergency Management Program in the Military Divi-
20 sion pursuant to Section 39-7110, Idaho Code.

21 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated and the Office of the State Con-
22 troller shall transfer \$25,000 from the General Fund to the Waste Tire Dis-
23 posal Deficiency Warrant Fund as soon as practicable for the period July 1,
24 2021, through June 30, 2022. Such moneys shall be used to reimburse costs in-
25 curred by the Waste Management and Remediation Program in the Department of
26 Environmental Quality pursuant to Section 39-6502, Idaho Code.

27 SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
28 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its
29 passage and approval.
