HOUSE BILL NO. 572

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO CIVIL AIR PATROL; AMENDING SECTION 39-7114A, IDAHO CODE, TO RE-
2 VISE PROVISIONS REGARDING CIVIL AIR PATROL, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADMIN-
3 ISTRATION OF CERTAIN MONEYS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR MEMORANDUMS OF UNDER-
4 STANDING REGARDING OPERATIONAL AND TRAINING MISSIONS; AND DECLARING AN
5 EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. That Section 39-7114A, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
9 amended to read as follows:

10 39-7114A. CIVIL AIR PATROL. (1) There is hereby established within the
11 military division ~~and the Idaho office of emergency management~~ the Idaho di-
12 rectorate of civil air patrol. The mission of the directorate shall be to
13 provide support for and facilitate the operation of the Idaho wing of civil
14 air patrol, Idaho wing, which shall be under the command and control of the
15 duly appointed commanding officer of such wing.

16 (2) In consideration for services rendered to the state of Idaho and its
17 citizens by the directorate of civil air patrol, Idaho wing, of civil air pa-
18 trol, the military division shall provide in-kind services or direct finan-
19 cial support to the directorate Idaho wing of civil air patrol, in the form
20 of land use, hangar facilities, mess and billeting facilities, office space,
21 travel, and participation fees for attendance at educational and training
22 opportunities sponsored by civil air patrol, and other entities when deemed
23 necessary and when such facilities are available. The military division
24 shall administer any moneys that may be appropriated from time to time for
25 the benefit of the Idaho wing of civil air patrol, by promptly transferring
26 said moneys to the Idaho wing of civil air patrol, by a grant or similar means
27 in an amount not less than the moneys appropriated. The military division
28 may specify such reporting requirements as it deems appropriate, and the
29 Idaho wing of civil air patrol shall make available to the military division
30 its financial records accounting for usage of any appropriated moneys.

31 (3) Any operational or training missions assigned to the Idaho wing of
32 civil air patrol by the Idaho office of emergency management and accepted for
33 execution by the Idaho wing of civil air patrol shall be governed by a sep-
34 arate memorandum of understanding that shall be executed from time to time
35 between the Idaho office of emergency management and civil air patrol. Any
36 reimbursement to the Idaho wing of civil air patrol of mission expenses spec-
37 ified by that memorandum of understanding shall be in addition to any appro-
38 priated moneys described in this section and shall be paid from moneys other-
39 wise available to the Idaho office of emergency management.

1 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
2 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after
3 July 1, 2022.
