AN ACT

1 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT
2 PROGRAM'S DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATORS; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE PUB-
3 LIC SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PROGRAM'S DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATORS
4 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023; APPROPRIATING GENERAL FUND MONEYS FOR TRANSFER
5 TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOL INCOME FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023; AMENDING SECTION
6 33-1004E, IDAHO CODE, TO INCREASE THE BASE SALARY FOR ADMINISTRATORS;
7 CLARIFYING THE ORIGINAL FUND SOURCE FOR EXPENDITURES IN THE PUBLIC
8 SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PROGRAM'S DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATORS FOR
9 FISCAL YEAR 2023; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS
10 EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PROGRAM'S DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATORS FOR FISCAL
11 YEAR 2022; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL GENERAL FUND MONEYS FOR TRANSFER
12 TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOL INCOME FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022; CLARIFYING THE
13 ORIGINAL FUND SOURCE FOR EXPENDITURES IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL
14 SUPPORT PROGRAM'S DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATORS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022; AND
15 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

17 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Public Schools Edu-
19 cational Support Program's Division of Administrators \$116,177,000 to be
20 expended from the Public School Income Fund for the period July 1, 2022,
21 through June 30, 2023.

22 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated and the Office of the State
23 Controller shall transfer \$116,177,000 from the General Fund to the Public
24 School Income Fund on July 1, 2022, or as soon thereafter as practicable for
25 the period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023.

26 SECTION 3. That Section 33-1004E, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
27 amended to read as follows:

28 33-1004E. DISTRICT'S SALARY-BASED APPORTIONMENT Each district shall
29 be entitled to a salary-based apportionment calculated as provided in this
30 section.

31 (1) To determine the apportionment for instructional staff, take
32 the amounts indicated on the career ladder table plus the amounts associ-
33 ated with the additional education allocation amounts pursuant to section
34 33-1004B, Idaho Code, and calculate the weighted average. The amount so
35 determined shall be multiplied by the district staff allowance for instruc-
36 tional staff determined as provided in section 33-1004(2), Idaho Code.
37 Full-time instructional staff salaries shall be determined from a salary
38 schedule developed by each district and submitted to the state department of
39 education. No full-time instructional staff member or pupil service staff
40 member on the residency compensation rung shall be paid less than the minimum

1 dollar amount on the career ladder residency compensation rung pursuant to
2 section 33-1004B, Idaho Code, for the applicable fiscal year.

3 (2) Effective July 1, 2022, no full-time instructional staff member
4 or pupil service staff member on the professional or advanced professional
5 compensation rung shall be paid less than the minimum dollar amount on the
6 career ladder professional compensation rung pursuant to section 33-1004B,
7 Idaho Code, for the applicable fiscal year.

8 (3) Effective July 1, 2025, no full-time instructional staff member or
9 pupil service staff member on the advanced professional compensation rung
10 shall be paid less than the minimum dollar amount on the advanced profes-
11 sional compensation rung pursuant to section 33-1004B, Idaho Code, for the
12 applicable fiscal year.

13 (4) If an instructional staff member has been certified by the national
14 board for professional teaching standards, the staff member shall receive
15 two thousand dollars (\$2,000) per year for five (5) years from the year in
16 which national board certification was earned. The district staff allot-
17 ment shall be increased by two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for each national
18 board-certified instructional staff member who earned national board cer-
19 tification; provided however, that no such awards shall be paid for the pe-
20 riod July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011, nor shall any liabilities accrue
21 or payments be made pursuant to this section in the future to any individu-
22 als who would have otherwise qualified for a payment during this stated time
23 period. The resulting amount is the district's salary-based apportionment
24 for instructional staff. For purposes of this section, teachers qualifying
25 for the salary increase shall be those who have been recognized as national
26 board-certified teachers as of July 1 of each year.

27 (5) To determine the apportionment for pupil service staff, take
28 the amounts indicated on the career ladder table plus the amounts associ-
29 ated with the additional education allocation amounts pursuant to section
30 33-1004B, Idaho Code, and calculate the weighted average. If the district
31 does not employ any pupil service staff, the district's pupil service staff
32 average salary shall equal the district's instructional staff average
33 salary for purposes of calculating pupil service salary-based apportion-
34 ment. The amount so determined shall be multiplied by the district staff al-
35 lowance for pupil service staff determined pursuant to section 33-1004(3),
36 Idaho Code. Full-time pupil service staff salaries shall be determined from
37 a salary schedule developed by each district and submitted to the state de-
38 partment of education. The resulting amount is the district's salary-based
39 apportionment for pupil service staff. No full-time pupil service staff
40 member shall be paid less than the minimum dollar amount on the career ladder
41 residency compensation rung pursuant to section 33-1004B, Idaho Code, for
42 the applicable fiscal year.

43 (6) To determine the apportionment for district administrative staff,
44 first determine the district average experience and education index by plac-
45 ing all eligible certificated administrative employees on the statewide
46 index provided in section 33-1004A, Idaho Code. The resulting average is the
47 district index. If the district does not employ any administrative staff,
48 the district administrative index shall equal the statewide average index
49 for purposes of calculating administrative salary-based apportionment. The
50 district administrative staff index shall be multiplied by the base salary

1 of ~~thirty-eight thousand seven hundred seventy-seven dollars (\$38,777)~~
2 forty-one thousand four hundred ninety-one dollars (\$41,491). The amount so
3 determined shall be multiplied by the district staff allowance for adminis-
4 trative staff determined as provided in section 33-1004(4), Idaho Code. The
5 resulting amount is the district's salary-based apportionment for adminis-
6 trative staff.

7 (7) To determine the apportionment for classified staff, multiply
8 twenty-three thousand two hundred sixteen dollars (\$23,216) by the district
9 classified staff allowance determined as provided in section 33-1004(5),
10 Idaho Code. The amount so determined is the district's apportionment for
11 classified staff.

12 (8) The district's salary-based apportionment shall be the sum of the
13 apportionments calculated in subsections (1), (4), (5), (6) and (7) of this
14 section, plus the benefit apportionment as provided in section 33-1004F,
15 Idaho Code.

16 SECTION 4. Of the amounts appropriated in Section 1 of this act for the
17 Public Schools Educational Support Program's Division of Administrators,
18 \$116,177,000 shall be considered expended from the General Fund for the pe-
19 riod July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023.

20 SECTION 5. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 3, Chap-
21 ter 312, Laws of 2021, and any other appropriation provided by law, there is
22 hereby appropriated to the Public Schools Educational Support Program for
23 the Division of Administrators \$2,820,800 from the Public School Income Fund
24 for the period July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022.

25 SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated and the Office of the State Con-
26 troller shall transfer \$2,820,800 from the General Fund to the Public School
27 Income Fund as soon as practicable for the period July 1, 2021, through June
28 30, 2022.

29 SECTION 7. Of the additional amounts appropriated in Section 5 of this
30 act for the Public Schools Educational Support Program's Division of Admin-
31 istrators, \$2,820,800 shall be considered expended from the General Fund for
32 the period July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022.

33 SECTION 8. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
34 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its
35 passage and approval.
