2	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE; AMENDING SECTION 41-2503, IDAHO CODE,
3	TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN POLICIES SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO PROVIDE COVERAGE
4	IN EXCESS OF THE LIABILITY COVERAGE OF ANY UNDERINSURED MOTOR VEHICLE
5	INVOLVED IN AN ACCIDENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EF-
3	FECTIVE DATE.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 41-2503, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 41-2503. DEFINITIONS AND APPLICATION. (1) For the purposes of uninsured motorist coverage, the term "uninsured motor vehicle" shall, subject to the terms and conditions of such coverage, be deemed to include an insured motor vehicle where the liability insurer thereof is unable to make payment with respect to the legal liability of its insured within the limits specified therein because of insolvency.
- (2) For purposes of underinsured motorist coverage, subject to the further definitions, terms and conditions of such coverage, the term "underinsured motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle that is a self-insured motor vehicle, or a motor vehicle that is covered by a policy of motor vehicle liability insurance or an indemnity bond, with limits for bodily injury or death at least equal to those limits set forth in section 49-117(20), Idaho Code.
- (3) With respect to policies issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2023, any underinsured motor vehicle coverage with limits of liability less than two (2) times the minimum limits for bodily injury or death specified in section 49-117(20), Idaho Code, shall be construed to provide coverage in excess of the liability coverage of any underinsured motor vehicle involved in the accident.
- $\underline{(4)}$ Except as provided in subsections (1) and (2) of this section, the terms and conditions of any policy of motor vehicle liability insurance providing uninsured motorist coverage or underinsured motorist coverage are not altered or amended.
- SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2022.
