The Legislative Services Office, Research and Legislation, has received the enclosed rules of the
Division of Occupational and Professional Licenses - State Board of Landscape Architects:
IDAPA 24.07.01 - Rules of the Idaho State Board of Landscape Architects (ZBR Chapter Repeal) -
Proposed Rule (Docket No. 24-0701-2301).

Pursuant to Section 67-454, Idaho Code, a meeting on the enclosed rules may be called by the
cochairmen or by two (2) or more members of the subcommittee giving oral or written notice to Research
and Legislation no later than fourteen (14) days after receipt of the rules' analysis from Legislative
Services. The final date to call a meeting on the enclosed rules is no later than 10/30/2023. If a meeting is
called, the subcommittee must hold the meeting within forty-two (42) days of receipt of the rules' analysis
from Legislative Services. The final date to hold a meeting on the enclosed rules is 11/27/2023.

The germane joint subcommittee may request a statement of economic impact with respect to a
proposed rule by notifying Research and Legislation. There is no time limit on requesting this statement,
and it may be requested whether or not a meeting on the proposed rule is called or after a meeting has
been held.

IDAPA 24.07.01 - Rules of the Idaho State Board of Landscape Architects (ZBR Chapter Repeal) - Proposed Rule (Docket No. 24-0701-2301)

Summary and Stated Reasons for the Rule

The Division of Occupational and Professional Licenses - State Board of Landscape Architects submits notice of proposed rulemaking at Docket No. 24-0701-2301 -- Rules of the Idaho State Board of Landscape Architects. This is a chapter repeal. Rules pertaining to Landscape Architects are being consolidated with rules for the Board of Architectural Examiners located at IDAPA 24.02.01. The Division states that no fees will be changed as a result of this rule repeal and consolidation.

NOTICE OF RULEMAKING – PROPOSED RULE

AUTHORITY: In compliance with Section 67-5221(1), Idaho Code, notice is hereby given that this agency has initiated proposed rulemaking procedures. The action is authorized pursuant to Section 67-2604, Idaho Code, and Sections 54-3003, 54-3003, 67-2614, 67-9406, and 67-9409, Idaho Code.

DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: The following is a nontechnical explanation of the substance and purpose of the proposed rulemaking:

This chapter of administrative rules is being repealed due to consolidation within the administrative rules chapter for the Board of Architectural Examiners, IDAPA 24.02.01. The result will be a combined rule chapter for the Board of Landscape Architects and the Board of Architectural Examiners.

FEE SUMMARY: The following is a specific description of the fee or charge imposed or increased:

The fees for applications, licenses, and reinstatement as designated in Rule 400 of IDAPA 24.02.01 are authorized in Section 54-3003, Idaho Code. None of these fees are being changed as a result of this rulemaking or since being previously reviewed by the Idaho legislature.
