HOUSE BILL NO. 320

BY EDUCATION COMMITTEE

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO COMMUNITY COLLEGES; AMENDING SECTION 33-2111, IDAHO CODE, TO
2 PROVIDE THAT A LEVY MAY NOT BE MADE UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES AND TO
3 MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 33-2111, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
7 amended to read as follows:

8 33-2111. TAXES AND OTHER FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR COMMUNITY COL-
9 LEGES. (1) For the maintenance and operation of each community college,
10 in addition to the income from tuition paid by students as ~~hereinbefore~~
11 provided in this chapter, the board of trustees may levy upon the taxable
12 property within the district a tax not to exceed one hundred twenty-five
13 thousandths percent (.125%) of the market value for assessment purposes on
14 all taxable property within the district.

15 (2) The tax levy determined by the board of trustees, within said limit,
16 shall be certified to the board of county commissioners in each county in
17 which the district may lie, ~~not~~ no later than the second Monday in September
18 of each year. No levy in excess of one hundred twenty-five thousandths per-
19 cent (.125%) of the market value for assessment purposes on all taxable prop-
20 erty within the district shall be made unless a supplemental levy in a spec-
21 ified amount ~~be~~ is first authorized through an election held, as provided
22 in title 34, Idaho Code, as if the community college district were a school
23 district and approved by a majority of the district electors voting in such
24 election.

25 (3) No levy may be made pursuant to this section for a community college
26 if the college's accreditation by the northwest commission on colleges and
27 universities has been revoked and has not been restored within two (2) years
28 of such revocation.

29 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
30 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its
31 passage and approval.
