1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE IDAHO
3 STATE POLICE RELATING TO RULES GOVERNING THE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY.

4 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

5 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
6 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the
7 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-
8 islative intent; and

9 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the
10 Idaho State Police relating to Rules Governing the Sex Offender Registry are
11 not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-
13 sion of the Sixty-seventh Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives
14 and the Senate concurring therein, that IDAPA 11.10.03, Rules Governing the
15 Sex Offender Registry, Rules of the Idaho State Police, adopted as a pend-
16 ing rule under Docket Number 11-1003-2201, Section 012., Subsection 06.a.,
17 only, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared null, void, and of no
18 force and effect.
