A HOUSE RESOLUTION

1 STATING FINDINGS OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND PROVIDING FOR THE  
2 AMENDMENT OF RULE 6 AND RULE 10 OF THE RULES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTA-  
3 TIVES.

5 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the House of Representatives deems it necessary and desir-  
7 able that Rule 6 and Rule 10 of the Rules of the House of Representatives be  
8 amended.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the House of Represen-  
10 tatives, assembled in the First Regular Session of the Sixty-seventh Idaho  
11 Legislature, that Rule 6 and Rule 10 of the Rules of the House of Representa-  
12 tives shall be amended to read as follows:

13 RULE 6

14 Bills -- Introduction. -- ~~(1) After the 20th day of any session~~ Except  
15 as provided in subsection (2) of this rule, no bill shall be introduced ex-  
16 cept by committees and after the 36th day no bill shall be introduced except  
17 by the State Affairs Committee, the Appropriations Committee, the Education  
18 Committee, the Revenue and Taxation Committee, the Health and Welfare Com-  
19 mittee, and the Ways and Means Committee. When essential to expedite the  
20 work of the House, the Speaker may designate any standing committee to serve  
21 as a privileged committee temporarily or during the remainder of the ses-  
22 sion.

23 (2) A bill may be introduced by submission thereof to the Chief Clerk,  
24 and such bill shall, after it is assigned a bill number, be maintained in the  
25 office of the Chief Clerk. The provisions of this subsection shall not apply  
26 to a concurrent resolution enabling a joint session of the House of Represen-  
27 tatives and the Senate at the commencement of the legislative session.

28 RULE 10

29 Reference of Bills. -- (1) All House bills, memorials and resolutions  
30 shall upon their introduction and first reading, be ordered printed by the  
31 Judiciary, Rules and Administration Committee. ~~When~~ Except for any bill  
32 submitted to the Chief Clerk pursuant to Rule 6(2), when reported printed by  
33 the Chief Clerk, the Speaker shall refer the instrument to a standing com-  
34 mittee, or shall order the instrument filed for second reading. All Senate  
35 bills, memorials and resolutions shall be referred directly by the Speaker  
36 to a standing committee or to the second reading calendar.

37 (2) If a bill, memorial or resolution is reported by the standing com-  
38 mittee to which it has been referred without amendment, it shall be placed  
39 upon the second reading calendar, but if such committee report a bill, memo-  
40 rial or resolution with amendments, the same with the amendments shall be

1 placed upon the general orders calendar for consideration by the Committee  
2 of the Whole House.
