

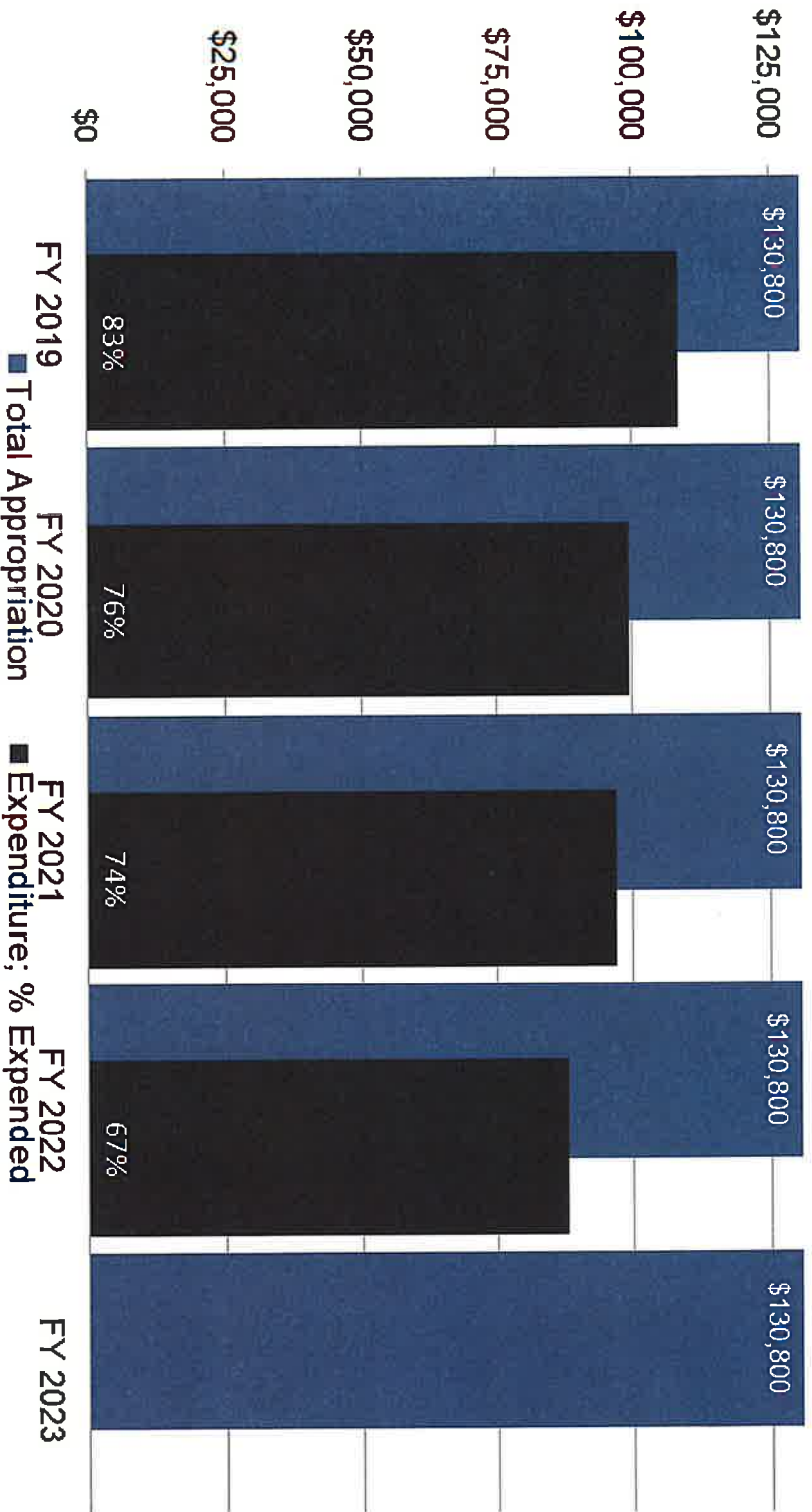

Agency Summary & Statutory Authority

The Idaho Judicial Council is empowered by statute to nominate individuals to the Office of the Governor to be confirmed for appointment to vacancies on the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, and District Courts and make recommendations to the Supreme Court for the removal, discipline, and retirement of judicial officers.

Total Appropriations and Expenditures by Year



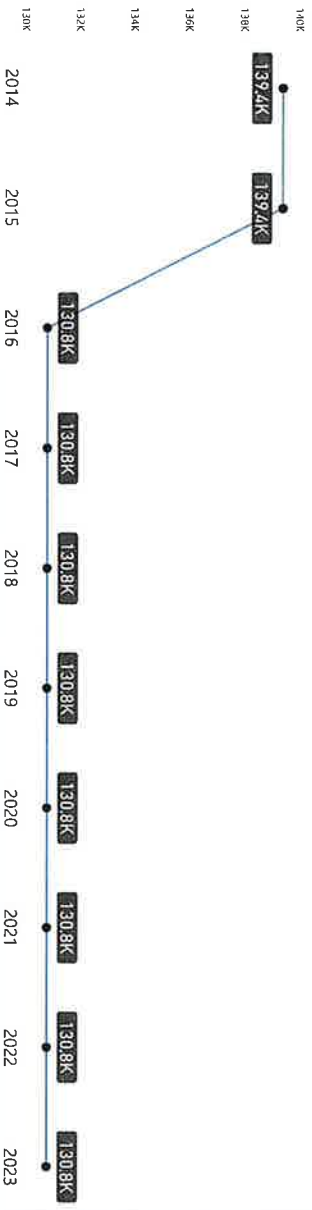
Agency Highlights

- The Judicial Branch has no FTP cap and is exempt from object and program transfer limitations found in Section 67-3511(1), (2), and (3), Idaho Code.
- From FY 2019 to FY 2022, on average, the agency expended 75.1% of its total appropriation, of which 98.6% was in operating expenditures.
- There are no audit findings to report.

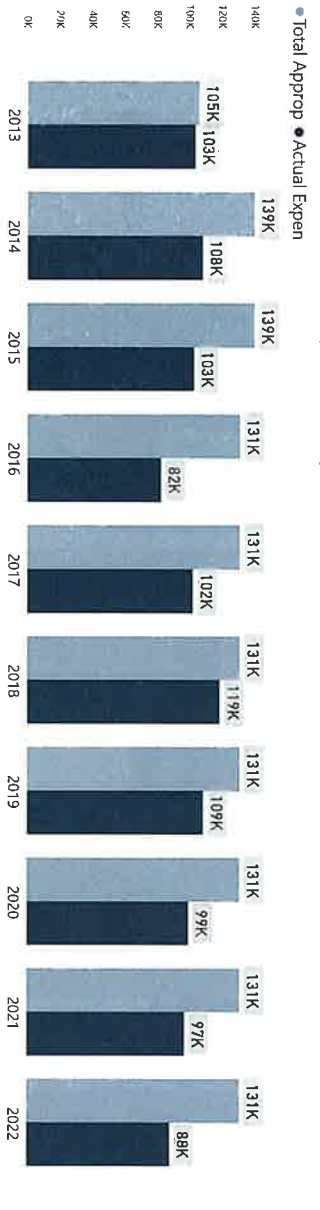
