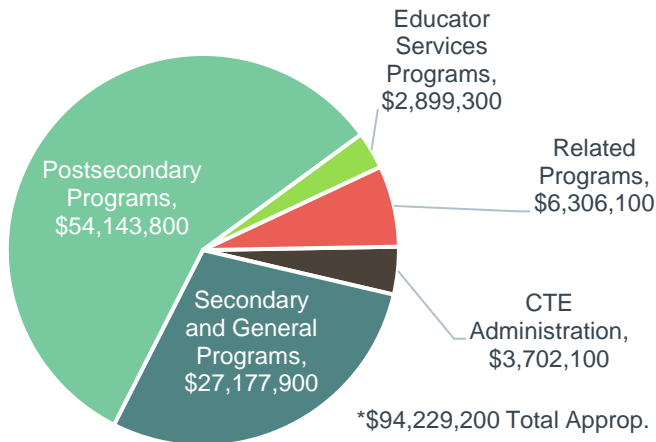




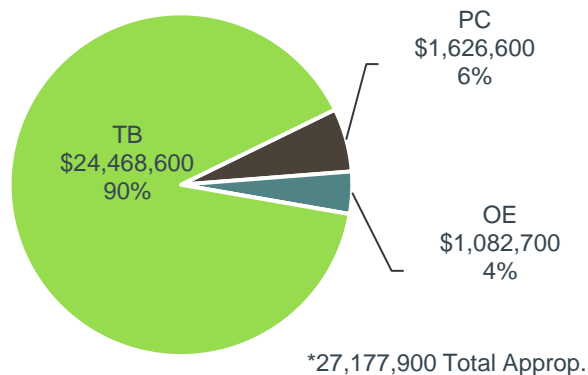
### Agency Summary & Statutory Authority

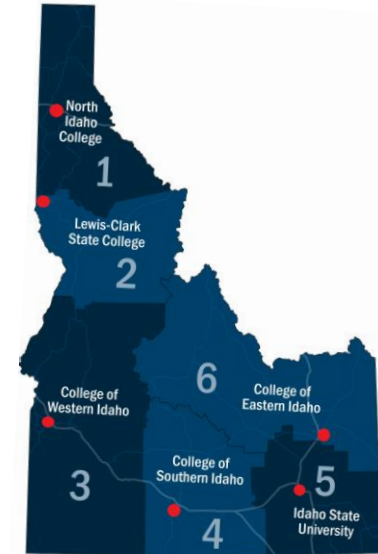
CTE Total Appropriation FY 2022

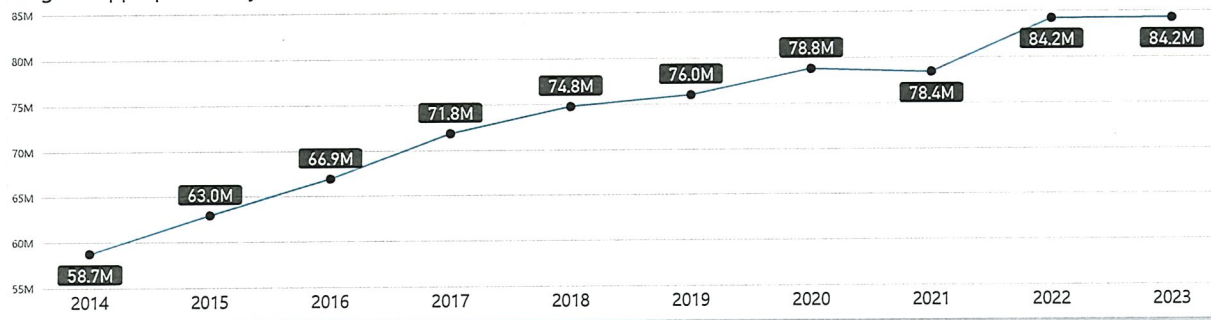
- The Division was authorized 586.01 FTP for FY 2022

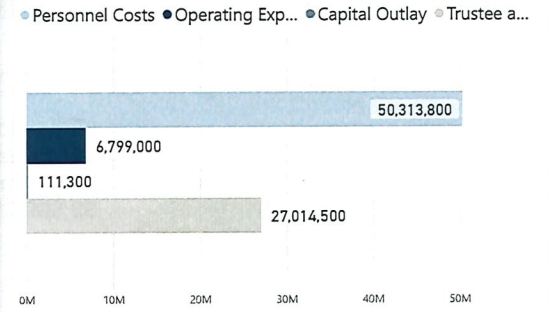

Original Appropriation by Fiscal Year



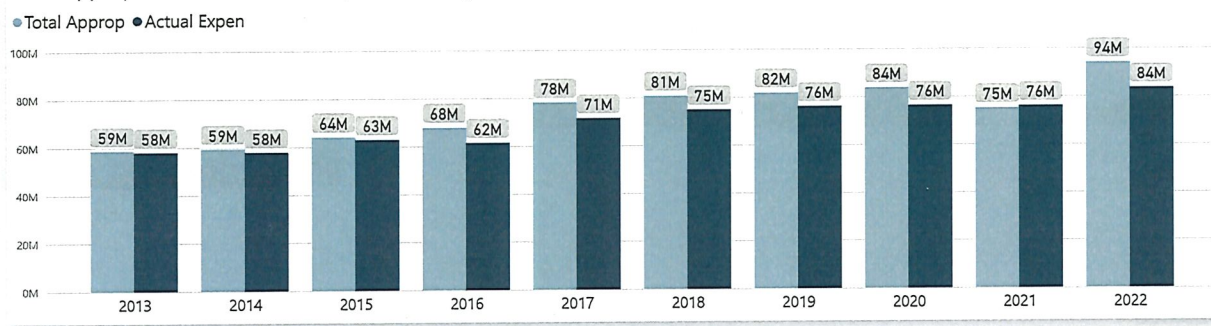
