RELATING TO COMMUNITY RESIDENT ASSOCIATIONS; AMENDING SECTION 55-2013A, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE PROVISIONS REGARDING CERTAIN NOTICES TO COMMUNITY RESIDENT ASSOCIATIONS AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

HOUSE BILL NO. 425 BY RESOURCES AND CONSERVATION COMMITTEE AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE DISASTER PREPAREDNESS; AMENDING SECTION 46-1021, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE A DEFINITION AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS; AMENDING SECTION 46-1022, IDAHO CODE, TO REMOVE A PROVISION REGARDING CERTAIN FLOODPLAIN ZONING ORDINANCES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
