Chair Yamamoto called the meeting to order at 9:00 am.

MOTION: **Rep. Sauter** made a motion to approve the minutes of January 16, 17, and 18, 2024. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

Jason Lords, Director of Instruction and Learning, Joint School District 93, spoke about driving student achievement using the Professional Learning Communities (PLC) Process. He shared four areas of focus; To provide extended learning opportunities, establish a guaranteed and viable curriculum, develop and use common formative assessments, and to provide systematic and tiered interventions.

RS 30977: **Rep. Sauter** presented **RS 30977**, proposed legislation concerning school board vacancies. He said the main points in this proposed legislation, addresses the number of school board members needed to make a quorum, when vacancy begins and recall elections.

MOTION: **Rep. Berch** made a motion to introduce **RS 30977**. **Motion carried by voice vote.** **Reps. Wisniewski, Hawkins and Price** requested to be recorded as voting **NAY**.
