About Amalgamated Sugar

1916, Twin Falls – 1917, Mini-Cassia – 1942,
Nampa

- **1897** – Founded
- **1912** – Came to Idaho
- **1997** – Became a Grower-Owned Cooperative
- **Today**
 - Contribute over \$1 billion to the Idaho economy
 - 1,700 employees, over \$135 million in payroll
 - 2nd largest beet sugar company in the United States
 - Produce 10% of the nation's Real Sugar

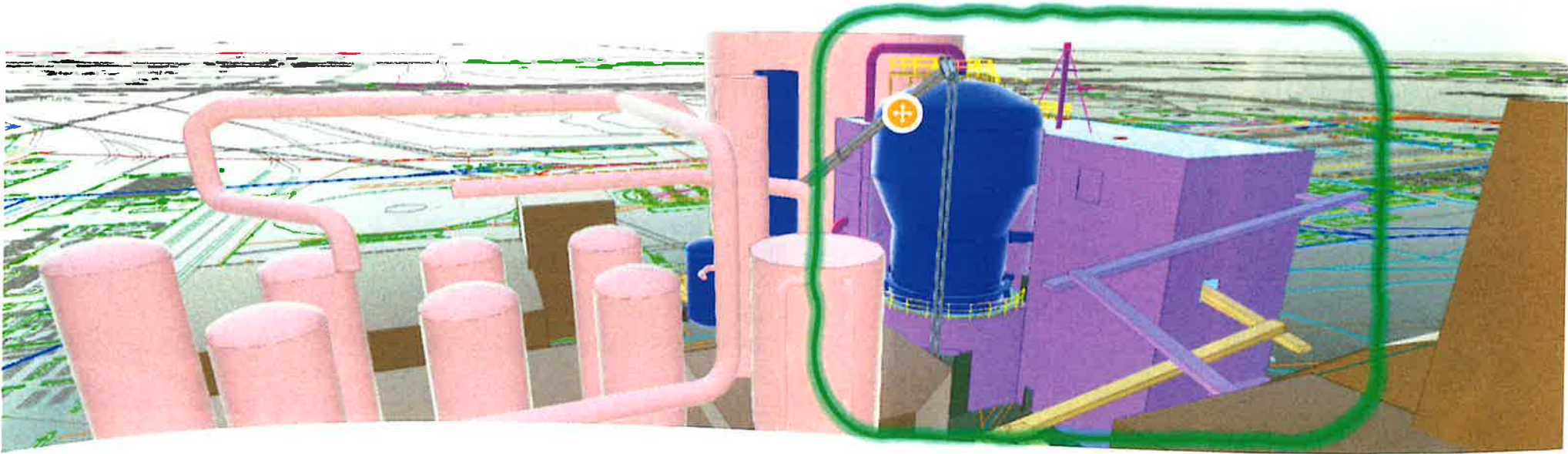


Nampa Anaerobic Digester

From Bugs to Biogas to Energy

- Microorganisms reduce organic strength of wastewater
- Converts into Biogas
- Biogas will be used to generate electricity (2 Megawatt)
- Treated and clarified water is recycled or discharged into the City of Nampa





Mini-Cassia Steam Dryer (Beet Pulp)

**+20% reduction of fuel consumption and emissions
(>40,000 metric tons of CO₂)**

- ~\$50 million Earnings Capital spend
- Eliminates two existing pulp dryers that burn natural gas and/or coal
- Will be powered by steam from the existing boiler house, resulting in nearly 100% energy savings
- Steam significantly reduces product loss
- Could qualify for federal tax credit

Youth Grower Projects

2023 – 170 youth, ages 8 to 18

- **1 Share (1 acre)** provided by the Cooperative
- **\$2,950** gross revenue for the 1 acre
- **\$501,615** contributed to youth through the Youth Grower Project
