

# STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

## RS24222

This is a fiscal year 2016 supplemental appropriation to the Department of Labor. The supplemental is in two parts. First, it includes \$1,553,100 for the State Longitudinal Data System and other activities, and second, it includes \$255,000 for unemployment insurance fraud prevention. The total FY 2016 supplemental appropriation is for \$1,808,100 all from the Miscellaneous Revenue Fund. For the first part of the supplemental, the State Longitudinal Data System requires \$1,290,700 to complete its work for the State Board of Education. There is an additional \$262,400 ongoing for other activities like job postings for the Division of Human Resources. The \$255,000 for the fraud prevention award from the National Association of State Workforce Agencies is to improve unemployment insurance program integrity by detecting and preventing benefit fraud.
