STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS24356C1

This legislation makes the following changes to city records retention laws.

(1) Provides a definition for "historical records" and requires such records to be retained in perpetuity by the city or transferred to the State Archives.

(2) Repeals Idaho Code 50-909 and incorporates the provisions of that section concerning retention of records using photographic or digital media into Idaho Code 50-907.

(3) Cities are authorized to retain permanent records using photographic or digital media, and to destroy paper originals of non-historical records preserved on photographic or digital media.

(4) Provisions concerning destruction of records that have met their required retention period match the current law, except for language clarifying that historical records cannot be destroyed.

FISCAL NOTE

No fiscal impact to the state. Small positive fiscal impact to cities due to eliminating the need to store large records like commercial building plans in paper form.
