STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS24667

This bill appropriates \$66,709,900 to the Supreme Court for FY 2017. The bill includes funding for the employer's share of increased benefit costs, increases in statewide cost allocation, and annualizations for two magistrate judges that were partially funded in FY 2016. It also provides for an ongoing 3% merit-based increase in employee compensation for permanent, non-judicial employees to be distributed at the discretion of the agency head. Five line items are also included, which provide: \$2,000,000 one-time from the Economic Recovery Reserve Fund for court technology; \$865,000 ongoing from the General Fund for senior judges; 1.00 FTP and \$443,300 for language access, of which \$249,300 is ongoing from the General Fund and \$194,000 is one-time from the Economic Recovery Reserve Fund; 1.00 FTP and \$118,000 ongoing from the General Fund for the Judicial Excellence and Education Program; and the net-zero program transfer of \$1,028,100 to the newly created Senior Judges Program, which was created for budgeting and accounting purposes.
