A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND RECOGNIZING COMMUNITY WATER FLUORI-DATION AS A GREAT PUBLIC HEALTH ACHIEVEMENT.
Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
WHEREAS, fluoridation of community water supplies is the single most effective public health measure to prevent tooth decay; and

7 WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has proclaimed 8 community water fluoridation as one of the ten great public health achieve-9 ments of the twentieth century; and

10 WHEREAS, studies prove water fluoridation continues to be effective 11 in reducing dental decay by at least twenty-five percent in children and 12 adults, even in the era of widespread availability of fluoride from other 13 sources, such as fluoride toothpaste; and

14 WHEREAS, water fluoridation has been improving the health of American 15 communities for over seventy years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-third Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and the Senate concurring therein, that the Idaho Legislature recognizes community water fluoridation as a vitally important public health initiative.
