## HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 3

## BY MCCROSTIE AND ERPELDING

A JOINT RESOLUTION
PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO RELATING TO
MARRIAGE; BY REPEALING SECTION 28, ARTICLE III, OF THE CONSTITUTION OF
THE STATE OF IDAHO, THAT PROVIDES A MARRIAGE BETWEEN A MAN AND A WOMAN IS
THE ONLY DOMESTIC LEGAL UNION THAT SHALL BE VALID OR RECOGNIZED IN THIS
STATE; STATING THE QUESTION TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE ELECTORATE; DIRECT-
ING THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO PREPARE THE STATEMENTS REQUIRED BY LAW;
AND DIRECTING THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO PUBLISH THE AMENDMENT AND ARGU-
MENTS AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

- 10 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
- SECTION 1. That Section 28, Article III, of the Constitution of the State of Idaho, be, and the same is hereby repealed.
  - SECTION 2. The question to be submitted to the electors of the State of Idaho at the next general election shall be as follows:
  - "Shall Section 28, Article III, of the Constitution of the State of Idaho be amended to repeal the state constitutional provision that provides a marriage between a man and a woman is the only domestic legal union that shall be valid or recognized in this state?".
- SECTION 3. The Legislative Council is directed to prepare the statements required by Section 67-453, Idaho Code, and file the same.
- 21 SECTION 4. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to publish this 22 proposed constitutional amendment and arguments as required by law.
