5	TO CONSTRUCT OR DEEPEN WELLS, TO PROVIDE CONDITIONS AND TO PROVIDE FOR
3	THE APPLICABILITY OF SPECIFIED LAW.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 3, Title 43, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a $\underline{\text{NEW SECTION}}$, to be known and designated as Section 43-344, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

- 43-344. AUTHORITY TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS FOR WELL CONSTRUCTION OR DEEPENING. (1) The board of directors of an irrigation district that operates and maintains at least fifty (50) irrigation wells and that possesses equipment and employs personnel that are capable of constructing or deepening a well shall have the power to enter into contracts to construct or deepen wells under the following conditions:
 - (a) Unless otherwise authorized by Idaho law, contracts for wells constructed or deepened for a political subdivision may be awarded only through the competitive bidding processes under chapter 28, title 67, Idaho Code. Provided however, the irrigation district shall not construct or deepen wells for a municipality.
 - (b) Contracts for the construction or deepening of a domestic well may be entered into only with landowners of the irrigation district.
 - (c) Contracts for the construction or deepening of a privately owned irrigation well may be entered into only provided that the well to be constructed or deepened is located within the boundaries of a water district created pursuant to section 42-604, Idaho Code, in which the irrigation district is included as a water user and the owner of the privately owned irrigation well cannot obtain the services of a private drilling company within fifteen (15) days.
- (2) The construction or deepening of any wells pursuant to this section shall be subject to the applicable requirements of sections 42-235 and 42-238, Idaho Code.
