## STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

## **RS24185**

This legislation changes the fine for the first infraction of not having mandatory motor vehicle liability insurance from seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) to one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00).

This legislation does not change present law making a second violation within five (5) years of the first offense a misdemeanor. Nor does it change the seventy-five dollar (\$75.00) fine for the first infraction of not carrying proof of liability insurance. It also leaves unchanged the motorist's right to avoid a penalty for failing to carry proof of liability insurance if he/she in fact had the required insurance and produces proof of it before conviction.

## **FISCAL NOTE**

This legislation increases a fine thereby creating a positive fiscal impact.
