## STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

## **RS24442**

Adds a new chapter to Title 33, Idaho Code affirming parental rights in education. The new chapter defines the reasonable accommodation offered to parents and guardians, outlines how school districts and public charter schools shall facilitate parental involvement in the education of their children, and provides that parents may withdraw their children from an activity or class. The act requires an annual notice of parental rights be distributed to parents and guardians.

## **FISCAL NOTE**

There will be no fiscal impact to the general fund. Title 1 schools are already required to have in place a parent participation plan, and school districts currently send their discipline and conduct policies to parents and guardians. There are only 4 school districts and 5 charter schools that currently do not receive Title 1 funds. Those districts that currently do not have such plans, may incur costs to develop participation plans.
