- RELATING TO DYED FUEL; AMENDING CHAPTER 6, TITLE 49, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 49-675, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT ANY VEHICLE
 SHALL BE SUBJECT TO INSPECTION FOR DYED DIESEL FUEL IN THE MOTOR VEHICLE'S DIESEL FUEL TANK UNDER SPECIFIED CONDITIONS.
- 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 6, Title 49, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 49-675, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

49-675. DYED FUEL -- INSPECTION. Upon probable cause, any vehicle 10 shall be subject to inspection for dyed diesel fuel in the motor vehicle's 11 diesel fuel tank when the operator is requested to submit to such inspection 12 by any peace officer at a fixed or portable check station established by 13 the Idaho transportation department pursuant to the provisions of section 14 40-510, Idaho Code, or when requested by any peace officer as a secondary ac-15 tion when the operator of the motor vehicle has been detained for a suspected 16 17 violation of another law.
