STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS24704

This is the fiscal year 2017 appropriation to the State Board of Education and the Board of Regents of the University of Idaho for the Health Education Programs in the amount of \$13,831,200 and 24.8 FTP. This appropriation includes benefit cost increases and one-time funding for replacement items. This appropriation also includes an ongoing 3% merit-based increase in employee compensation for permanent employees to be distributed at the discretion of agency heads, and one-time funding for the 27th payroll. Additionally, three line items are included. Line item 2 provides an FTP and funding for five new medical students in the WWAMI Program, line item 4 provides ongoing funding for two new medical students at the University of Utah Medical School Program, and line item 5 provides funding for six additional residents to the Kootenai Health Family Medicine Residencies Program. This appropriation is an increase of 5.6% increase in the General Fund, and a 5.6% increase in total funds.
