STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING CERTAIN RULES OF THE DE-PARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION RELATING TO RULES GOVERNING CAPITOL MALL PARKING.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with legislative intent; and

WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the Department of Administration relating to Rules Governing Capitol Mall Parking are not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-third Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Representatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 38.04.04, Rules of the Department of Administration, Rules Governing Capitol Mall Parking, Section 022., Subsections 02.b. and 08.d., and Section 040., Subsections 02.g. and 02.h., only, adopted as pending rules under Docket Number 38-0404-1501, be, and the same are hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no force and effect.
