

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS24893

This bill amends the Board of Pharmacy's qualifications for licensure by reciprocity. Specifically, this bill clarifies that an applicant is not eligible for license transfer if they are under active discipline in another state in a manner that prevents the applicant from practicing pharmacy. This bill is in compliance with the intent of the model act of the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP), the association that facilitates license transfer requests from pharmacists on behalf of Boards of Pharmacy in all 50 states and the District of Columbia.

FISCAL NOTE

This legislation will have no fiscal impact to the General Fund or the Board of Pharmacy's dedicated fund. It has no fiscal impact because it clarifies who is eligible for license reciprocity and does not create any new requirements or workload for Board of Pharmacy staff.
