STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS25378

This is the FY 2018 appropriation to the Public Employee Retirement System of Idaho (PERSI) for \$7,947,900 in dedicated funds with full-time equivalent positions capped at sixty-seven (67). It includes \$56,800 in benefit cost increases, \$300,700 for replacement items, \$18,100 for statewide cost allocation, and \$120,900 for an ongoing 3% merit-based increase in employee compensation for permanent employees to be distributed at the discretion of agency heads and institution presidents.

The bill includes one additional FTP and \$76,000 for a new internal training specialist in line item 1. Line item 2 includes a reduction of \$45,300 in operating expenditures in the PERSI Administrative Fund and an increase of \$45,300 in personnel costs in the PERSI Special Fund. This action nets to zero to fund the amount already committed to salaries in FY 2017. Cybersecurity insurance costs for FY 2018 are also included in the amount of \$5,400.

Intent language is included in Section 3 of the bill, referencing language allowing for continuous appropriation of PERSI's portfolio-related costs.
