## STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

## RS25385

Appropriates \$1,300,700 to the Office of Energy and Mineral Resources for fiscal year 2018 and caps the number of authorized full-time equivalent positions at 8. The bill includes funding for increased costs for health insurance, includes funding for replacement items, and accounts for an increase in statewide cost allocation. It also includes an ongoing 3% merit-based increase in employee compensation for permanent employees.

There are two line-items. The first provides \$58,000 from the Petroleum Price Violation Fund for the Government by Example Program to expand energy audits of state and local buildings. The second includes \$5,200 from the Petroleum Price Violation Fund for a paid intern.
