## STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

## RS25442

This is the fiscal year 2018 appropriation to the State Board of Education and the Board of Regents of the University of Idaho for Special Programs in the amount of \$19,686,640. Special Programs includes Forest Utilization Research, Geological Survey, Scholarships and Grants, the Museum of Natural History, Small Business Development Centers, and TechHelp. This appropriation includes benefit cost increases, one-time funding for replacement items, and an ongoing 3% merit-based increase in compensation for permanent employees for be distributed at the discretion of agency heads and institution presidents.

There are two line items included in this appropriation:

Line item 2 provides Scholarship and Grants Program \$1,400,000 from Federal Funds to provide additional GEAR UP scholarships for disadvantaged youth;

Line item 3 provides 1.00 FTP and funding to the Museum of Natural History hire a development officer;

This appropriation limits the number of full-time personnel to 43.13, and is a 0.09% increase in the General Fund and 8.40% increase in total funds as compared to FY 2017.
