SECTION 4. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In addition to any other authorization provided by law, the full-time equivalent position authorization provided to the Idaho State Police for the Patrol Program is increased by one (1) for the period July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2018.

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SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT -- WATERCRAFT INSPECTION PROGRAM. It is the intent of the Legislature that the Idaho State Department of Agriculture (ISDA) maximize the use of the appropriation provided for the Watercraft Inspection Program to minimize the chances of spreading zebra mussels, guagga mussels, and other aquatic invasive species into Idaho waters. The department is encouraged to use roving inspection stations when appropriate and for expanded hours of coverage during holidays when boat transport traffic is likely to increase. It is also encouraged to use extra staffing on busy holiday weekends. The department shall gather data regarding the number of watercraft that are bypassing the stations and shall gather data regarding nighttime transport of watercraft across Idaho's borders. Furthermore, it is the intent of the Legislature that ISDA seek to secure federal funding to further enhance invasive species detection and prevention efforts. The ISDA shall report back to the Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee, the Senate Agricultural Affairs Committee and the House of Representatives Agricultural Affairs Committee, during the 2018 legislative session, the results of the data gathering, securement of federal funds and an operational review of the boat stations.
