RELATING TO LEGAL NOTICES OF GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES; AMENDING CHAPTER 1, TI-2 TLE 60, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 60-106B, IDAHO CODE, 3 TO PROVIDE FOR ELECTRONIC PUBLICATION OF LEGAL NOTICES ON GOVERNMENT 4 5 WEBSITES, TO PROVIDE REQUIREMENTS AND TO DEFINE TERMS.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho: 6

SECTION 1. That Chapter 1, Title 60, Idaho Code, be, and the same is 7 8 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and des-9 ignated as Section 60-106B, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

60-106B. ELECTRONIC PUBLICATION OF LEGAL NOTICES ON GOVERNMENT WEB-10 SITES. (1) In lieu of the newspaper publication required by section 60-106, 11 12 Idaho Code, legal notices, advertisements or publications of any kind required or provided by the laws of the state of Idaho to be published in a 13 newspaper may be electronically published by governmental entities. An 14 electronically published legal notice, advertisement or publication shall 15 have the same legal effect as a legal notice, advertisement or publication 16 that is published in a newspaper. A tab on the governmental entity's home-17 page must clearly be marked "Public Notices" wherein all electronically 18 published public notices may be found. The governmental entity shall keep a 19 historical record of the posting, including the time and date of the posting. 20 Governmental entities must still adhere to all advance requirements regard-21 22 ing days of notice prior to government action and the provisions of section 23 74-204, Idaho Code, shall be complied with. A governmental entity must use an official website if it provides notice pursuant to this section. 24

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(2) The following definitions apply to this section:

(a) "Electronically published" means the printing and disseminating of 26 legal notices, advertisements or publications through the use of mes-27 saging on the governmental entity's website. 28

(b) "Messaging" means the use of interconnected electronic networks 29 that automatically transmit data from one computer to another. 30

(3) The following provisions apply to this section: 31

(a) Electronic publication shall be in lieu of the required printed 32 33 publication in a newspaper; and

(b) Nothing in this section shall be construed to require a governmen-34 tal entity to develop and maintain an electronic publication capabil-35 36 ity.

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
