A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING CERTAIN RULES OF THE IDAHO
STATE POLICE RELATING TO RULES GOVERNING SIMULCASTING.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with legislative intent; and

WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the Idaho State Police, Rules Governing Simulcasting are not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Session of the Sixty-fourth Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and the Senate concurring therein, that IDAPA 11.04.02, Rules Governing Simulcasting, final rule Section 010., Subsections 06. and 13., and final rule Sections 047., 049., 050., 051., 056. and 057., only, be, and the same are hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no force and effect.
