- 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

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6 SECTION 1. That Section 72-1345A, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 7 amended to read as follows:

8 72-1345A. IDAHO CAREER INFORMATION SYSTEM. The Idaho career information system is hereby established within the department to provide current 9 and accurate occupational, educational and related career information to 10 help Idaho citizens understand the link between educational preparation 11 12 and work, explore education and career alternatives, and successfully seek work. The Idaho career information system shall be responsible for carry-13 ing out the duties required by section 118 of the Carl D. Perkins career and 14 technical education act of 2006 (20 U.S.C. 2328(c)), as amended. All moneys 15 received by the Idaho career information system for its products and ser-16 vices shall be deposited in the career information system account, which is 17 hereby established in the state treasury, subject to appropriation. Employ-18 ees of the Idaho career information system shall be nonclassified classified 19 employees exempt from under the provisions of chapter 53, title 67, Idaho 20 Code. The workforce development council established pursuant to section 21 22 72-1336, Idaho Code, shall serve as an advisory body to the department on 23 matters related to the Idaho career information system.
