AMENDMENT TO SECTION 2

On page 7 of the engrossed bill, in line 8, delete "create a separate civil cause of action" and insert: "preclude a person from pursuing a private cause of action under chapter 6, title 48, Idaho Code".

AMENDMENT TO SECTION 3

On page 11, in line 33, delete "create a separate civil cause of action" and insert: "preclude a person from pursuing a private cause of action under chapter 6, title 48, Idaho Code".

9 AMENDMENT TO THE BILL

On page 11, following line 33, insert:

"SECTION 4. That Section 41-114A, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 41-114A. SERVICE CONTRACTS. (1) The term "service contract," as used in this section, means a contract or agreement for a separately stated consideration for a specific duration to perform the repair, replacement or maintenance of property or to reimburse, in whole or in part, the owner of such property for the repair, replacement or maintenance of property if an operational or structural failure is due to a defect in materials or manufacturing or to normal wear and tear. A service contract may contain a provision for incidental payment under such contract where service, repair or replacement is not feasible or economical. Service contracts, other than motor vehicle service contracts subject to the provisions of the Idaho motor vehicle service contract act, chapter 2862, title 491, Idaho Code, may provide for the repair, replacement or maintenance of property for damage resulting from power surges and accidental damage from handling.
- (2) The marketing, sale, offering for sale, issuance, making, proposing to make, and administration of a service contract is exempt from the provisions of title 41, Idaho Code.
- (3) Service contracts shall be subject to the provisions of the Idaho consumer protection act, chapter 6, title 48, Idaho Code.
- SECTION 5. That Section 48-605, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 48-605. EXCEPTIONS TO CHAPTER. Nothing in this act shall apply to:

(1) Actions or transactions permitted under laws administered by the state public utility commission or other regulatory body or officer acting under statutory authority of this state or the United States.

- (2) Acts done by publishers, broadcasters, printers, retailers, or their employees, in the publication or dissemination of an advertisement in good faith on the basis of information or material supplied by others and without knowledge or reason to know of the misleading or deceptive character of such advertisement or the information or material furnished.
- (3) Persons subject to chapter 13, title 41, Idaho Code (sections 41-1301 through 41-1327), defining, and providing for the determination by the director of the department of insurance of unfair methods of competition or unfair or deceptive acts or practices in the business of insurance, except as specified in chapter 62 or 63, title 41, Idaho Code.".

CORRECTION TO TITLE
