- Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho: 5
- SECTION 1. That Section 18-7034, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 6 amended to read as follows: 7
 - 18-7034. UNLAWFUL ENTRY A MISDEMEANOR. Every person, except under landlord-tenant relationship, who enters any dwelling house, apartment, tenement, shop, warehouse, store, mill, barn, stable, outhouse or other building, tent, vessel, closed vehicle, closed trailer, airplane, railroad car or outbuilding, without the consent of the owner of such property or his agent or any person in lawful possession thereof, is guilty of a misdemeanor unless the person is being pursued by law enforcement officials, in which case the person is guilty of a felony. Economic loss caused by an unlawful entry is recoverable pursuant to section 19-5304, Idaho Code.
