## SENATE BILL NO. 1096

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 10, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 33-1004G, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

33-1004G. SCHOOL DISTRICT EMPLOYER HEALTH CARE COST ADJUSTMENTS. The legislature finds that school districts and charter schools are faced with a steep increase in the employer portion of school district employee health insurance costs, and that it is equitable to provide funds at the same proportion of state employee health care cost adjustments. Therefore, a portion of the moneys appropriated to the public schools educational support program shall be distributed to each school district and charter school in an amount equal to the staff allowances under section 33-1004, Idaho Code, multiplied by the amount appropriated for the employer cost adjustment per full-time equivalent employee for the state of Idaho state employee group insurance plan authorized under section 67-5764, Idaho Code, for the same fiscal year.
