16 17 18	(c) Advanced practice professional nurses, including certified nurse-midwives, clinical nurse specialists, nurse practitioners and certified registered nurse anesthetists licensed or registered pursuant to

22 23 24	(e) Medical personnel when making an emergency response to a "911" call from a custodial parent, for the purpose of taking temporary physical custody of a child pursuant to the provisions of this act. For purposes
25 26 27	of this act, "medical personnel" shall include those individuals certified by the department of health and welfare as: (i) First responders;
28 29	(ii) Emergency medical technicians - basic;(iii) Advanced emergency medical technicians - ambulance;
