Chairman Barbieri called the meeting to order at 1:31 p.m.

S 1117: Senator Steven Thayn presented **S 1117**, legislation intended to make it easier to create self-funded health insurance plans. The bill adds to the current law giving authority to the Director of Insurance to extend, by up to 12 months, the time period a self-funded plan has to meet the minimum surplus. All other requirements must be met.

In answer to committee questions, **Dean Cameron**, Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance, confirmed this legislation allows up to 24 months for self-funded plans to increase their surplus levels.

- MOTION: Rep. Kloc made a motion to send S 1117 to the floor with a DO PASS recommendation. Motion carried by voice vote. Rep. Kloc will sponsor the bill on the floor.
- **SCR 112:** Senator Jim Patrick presented SCR 112. This legislation rejects a certain rule of the Division of Building Safety, Docket No. 07-0501-1601, relating to rules of the Public Works Contractors License Board.
- MOTION: Rep. Palmer made a motion to send SCR 112 to the floor with a DO PASS recommendation. Motion carried by voice vote. Rep. Dixon will sponsor the bill on the floor.
