2 3 4	RELATING TO RAILROADS; AMENDING CHAPTER 4, TITLE 62, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 62-425, IDAHO CODE, TO ESTABLISH PROVISIONS REGARDING CREW REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAINS OR LOCOMOTIVES.
5	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
6 7 8	SECTION 1. That Chapter 4, Title 62, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u> , to be known and designated as Section 62-425, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
9 10	62-425. CREW REQUIREMENTS. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, a railroad that operates a train or locomotive in this state,
11 12	and any officer of such railroad, shall ensure that the train or locomotive contains a crew of not less than two (2) persons.
13	(2) The provisions of subsection (1) of this section do not apply to a
14	train or locomotive engaged in helper or hostling services.
15	(3) A railroad or railroad officer who violates subsection (1) of this
16	section is liable to the public utilities commission for a civil penalty of:
17	(a) Not less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for the first viola-
18	tion; and
19	(b) Not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the second and any
20	subsequent violation within three (3) years of the first violation.
21	(4) As used in this section:
22	(a) "Helper services" means connecting a locomotive to the front or
23	back of a train to assist the train in ascending or descending a grade.

(b) "Hostling services" means moving a train or locomotive a short dis-

(c) "Railroad" means a class I freight railroad, class I railroad or

class II railroad as those terms are defined in 40 CFR 1033.901.
