SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Department of Agriculture is authorized no more than two hundred seventeen (217.00) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 3. WATERCRAFT INSPECTION PROGRAM. It is the intent of the Leg-28 islature that the Idaho State Department of Agriculture (ISDA) shall max-29 imize the use of the appropriation provided for the Watercraft Inspection 30 Program to minimize the chances of spreading zebra mussels, guagga mussels, 31 and other aquatic invasive species into Idaho waters. The department is en-32 couraged to use roving inspection stations when appropriate and for expanded 33 hours of coverage during holidays when boat transport traffic is likely to 34 35 increase. It is also encouraged to use extra staffing on busy holiday weekends. The department shall gather data regarding the number of watercraft 36 that are bypassing the stations and nighttime transport of watercraft across 37 Idaho's borders. Furthermore, it is the intent of the Legislature that ISDA 38 shall seek to secure federal funding to further enhance invasive species de-39 tection and prevention efforts. The ISDA shall report back to the Joint Fi-40

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1 nance-Appropriations Committee, the Senate Agricultural Affairs Committee,

2 and the House Agricultural Affairs Committee, during the 2019 legislative

3 session, regarding the results of the data gathering, attainment of federal

4 funds, and an operational review of the boat stations.
