AN ACT

2 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019;

3 APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019;

4 LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; AND PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE INTENT FOR THE ELECTIONS SYSTEM UPGRADE.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Secretary of State the following amounts to be expended according to the designated programs and expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019:

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Secretary of State is authorized no more than twenty-nine (29.00) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 3. ELECTIONS SYSTEM UPGRADE. It is the intent of the Legislature that the Secretary of State shall provide the Legislative Services Office with the necessary information on the elections system upgrade to allow

the Legislature to make informed decisions regarding the amounts appropriated in Section 1 of this act, and any other future funding requests. Information provided shall address the merit, need, cost, compatibility, and maintenance of the elections system upgrade. Further, periodic updates and reports may be requested by the Legislative Services Office from the Secretary of State to be provided to the Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee.
