- 9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
 - SECTION 1. That Chapter 3, Title 5, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 5-344, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
 - 5-344. IMMUNITY -- AID TO PERSON IN VEHICLE. A person is immune from civil liability for entry, including forced entry and any resulting property damage, into a motor vehicle for the purpose of removing another person from the vehicle, provided that the person entering:
 - (1) Has a reasonable, good-faith belief that the other person is in imminent danger of suffering death or serious bodily harm; and
 - (2) If feasible, contacts law enforcement before or immediately after entering.
 - SECTION 2. That Chapter 70, Title 18, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 18-7044, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
 - 18-7044. IMMUNITY -- AID TO PERSON IN VEHICLE. A person shall not be prosecuted under this title for entry, including forced entry and any resulting property damage, into a motor vehicle for the purpose of removing another person from the vehicle, provided that the person entering:
 - (1) Has a reasonable, good-faith belief that the other person is in imminent danger of suffering death or serious bodily harm; and
 - (2) If feasible, contacts law enforcement before or immediately after entering.
- 32 SECTION 3. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby 33 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its 34 passage and approval.
