Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 1, Title 22, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 22-114, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

- 22-114. AUTHORITY AND DUTIES OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE IDAHO STATE DE-PARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE CONCERNING POISONOUS PLANTS -- LABEL REQUIREMENTS -- PUBLIC OUTREACH. (1) Any person or entity that offers for sale any poisonous plant shall be required to conspicuously adhere to the container of the plant a red label measuring a minimum of eight (8) inches by eight (8) inches in size, with the word "Poison" appearing in black.
- (2) For purposes of this section, "poisonous" means having the capacity to produce injury or illness to a human being or animal, domestic or wild, through ingestion of the plant.
- (4) The director of the Idaho state department of agriculture shall cause a public awareness and outreach program to be conducted to inform the public about the dangers that poisonous plants pose to humans and animals, both domestic and wild. The director shall determine what plants are poisonous for the purposes of this section and compile and keep current a list of such poisonous plants, which list shall be published and incorporated in the rules of the director.
