RELATING TO DENTISTS; AMENDING SECTION 54-916B, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE PROVI-

3	SIONS REGARDING LICENSURE BY CREDENTIALS.
4	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
5 6	SECTION 1. That Section $54-916B$ , Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:
7 8	54-916B. DENTAL LICENSURE BY CREDENTIALS. The board may issue a license to practice dentistry without further examination upon evidence that:
9 10	(1) The applicant currently holds an active license in good standing to practice dentistry in another state with no disciplinary proceedings or un-
11	resolved complaints pending before the state's licensing board;
12	(2) The applicant has been in clinical practice at least five (5) years
13	immediately preceding the date of application for a minimum of one three
14	thousand <u>five hundred</u> ( <del>1,000</del> <u>3,500</u> ) hours <del>in each year;</del>
15	(3) The applicant has graduated from a dental school accredited by the
16	commission on dental accreditation of the American dental association as of
17	the date of the applicant's graduation;
18	(4) The applicant has successfully completed the national board dental
19	examinations;
20	(5) The applicant has successfully completed a board-approved clinical

(6) The applicant has paid the application fee as set by board rule.
