STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS26409

This is the FY 2019 original appropriation bill for the Office of Information Technology Services. It appropriates \$5,870,200 and caps the number of authorized full-time equivalent positions at 30.00. The bill funds six line items. Line item 1 provides 29.00 FTP and \$4,282,800 as a result of H607, which removes the Information Technology Division from the Department of Administration and creates a new Office of Information Technology Services in the Office of the Governor. Line items 2 - 6 provide 1.00 FTP and \$86,600 for an information technology systems analyst; \$175,300 for Domain Services Hardware; \$628,500 for Server and Storage Replacement; \$506,000 for Video Conference Bridge Replacement; and \$191,000 for Information Technology Functionality.
